



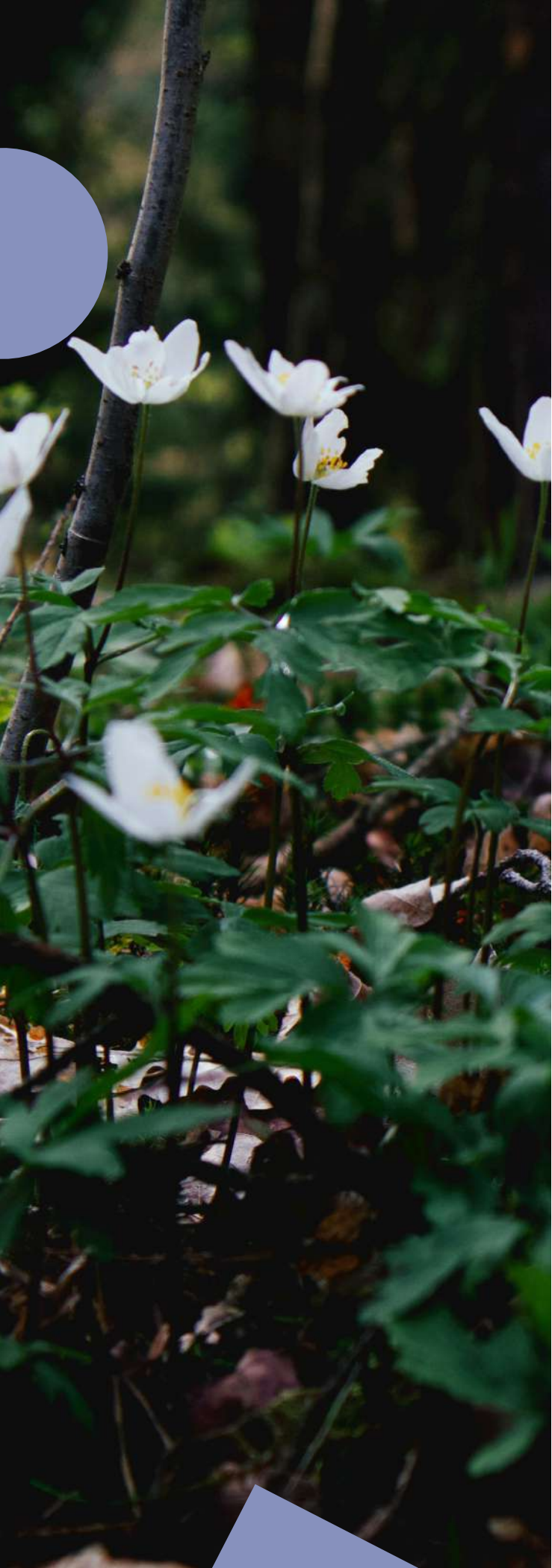

TOGETHER

BACK IN TIME

WE MEET WITH TWO LOCALS IN **SKUJENE - GUNTARS** AND **LAILA ZEILES**, WHO HAVE TURNED A COMMON HOBBY INTO AN EXCITING ADVENTURE. GUNTARS AND LAILA HAVE FOUND A LOVE FOR COLLECTING ANTIQUES, WHICH LED TO THE FOUNDING OF AN UNIQUE MUSEUM. OVER SEVEN MAGICAL YEARS, THE MUSEUM HAS BECOME A TREASURE TROVE OF DONATED RELICS, REVEALING THEIR STORIES FROM CĒSIS COUNTY AND BEYOND.

How did the idea to create the “Antiquities Museum” in Skujene come about?

When our children grew up, we discovered a new hobby - collecting antiques. Seven years ago, we started renting a hangar where we displayed our collection, and later we opened a museum. Over time, the collection grew, receiving donations from the local area and other parts of Latvia, and the hangars were filled with antiques. There are also people who have entrusted their property for storage temporarily until they themselves need it.

One thing is clear, these are not just old objects.

What do they mean to you? Antiques are not just objects, but memories and values from the past. An old item can take people back to long-forgotten moments from life, childhood. It's also about preserving and passing on our own history to future generations. For example, in the exhibition, you can find the carriage harness from Skujene Manor, and the dress of an unknown noblewoman.

Is there an exhibit in the museum that is more special to you than others?

All exhibits are dear to us, but if one has to be mentioned, then it's Guntar's great-grandfather's christening robe dating back to 1899, and for Laila - wooden horses. There's a very special story about one particular antique in the museum - the Zhiguli. How did we come into possession of the Zhiguli in the museum? The guys from the neighboring village offered it to the museum. We agreed but insisted that we wouldn't buy it. The owners responded that they knew that and they were giving away the Zhiguli. We objected - we couldn't take it for free, but they said either we take the Zhiguli or they would scrap it. In the end, we faced each other, so to speak. On the day of the meeting, we realized that the previous day had been a bit “sour” for the owners. Well, so that neither I nor they would be sour, we “bought” the Zhiguli, paying with a bottle of vodka.

What is the farthest place from which an exhibit has traveled to the museum?

A dowry chest has come from Belarus, blouses from America. The dowry chest from Belarus was given to us by a man who received it from his grandmother's estate. On the other hand, the blouses from America were made in Latvia. Initially, they traveled from Skujene to America and then back to Skujene. Meanwhile, exhibits from Latvia have come from almost all directions, except from the Ventspils and Talsi sides.

What amusing moments have you experienced in the museum?

A girl, about 14 or 15 years old, took an ordinary landline telephone in her hands, turned it around, and asked how we went to school with such a thing. At that moment, there was complete silence in my head for a couple of seconds, but when I started to explain that it wasn't taken anywhere, that it was standing at home on the table, and the wire was stuck in the wall, the girl's world turned upside down.

Where do you find the time and drive to continue?

The drive that sustains and propels our museum is our shared hobby - a passion. It also creates the necessary motivation and desire to act. Great support comes from family and friends, as well as from every visitor who shows genuine interest in our museum.

GET READY FOR CYCLING SEASON

IT'S SPRINGTIME, TIME TO CHECK YOUR BIKE AND GET READY FOR YOUR NEXT ADVENTURES WITH FRIENDS! HERE ARE CYCLING MASTER **JĀNIS RATSEPS** TIPS ON HOW TO ENJOY A SAFE AND PLEASANT RIDE!



TIRES

When spring arrives, it's important to check your bike's tires and adjust the air pressure. For mountain bikes, the pressure should be 2-3 atmospheres, while for city bikes, it should be 3-3.5 atmospheres. Carefully inspect the condition of the tires and tread wear, and be sure to check for any sidewall cracks. If you find any cracks, replace the tires immediately!



BRAKES

Before riding, squeeze the brake levers to make sure the brakes are working effectively. It may be necessary to apply some lubricant. Also, don't forget to check the gear shifters to ensure they are working properly after the winter break.

CHAIN

After the winter season, it's often necessary to oil the bike chain to ensure its proper functioning. However, be cautious - if the bike has been in a damp place, the chain may be heavily rusted and may need to be replaced. City bikes equipped with gears in the rear wheel hub and a coaster brake may also require chain tensioning, as it tends to stretch over time.

Remember! When riding a bike, always follow safety rules, wear a helmet, and use lights or reflective vests if riding in the dark.

SWING ROAD IN DZĒRBENE

Length: **5 km**

Difficulty level: **easy**

Suitable for children

The Swing Road in **Dzērbene** is designed for everyone, locals and visitors alike, to enjoy a scenic bike ride or walk through the most picturesque areas of **Dzērbene** - to enjoy the beautiful nature, breathe fresh air, and draw inspiration from the wise locals.

Each swing carries its own story - about life, history, or the people who once lived here. Swinging on the swings, you will not only feel freedom but also travel through time, as the inscriptions on the swings range from ancient times to just a few decades ago.

During the walk, also visit **Dzērbenes Castle Park**, **the High Mountain** and **Dzērbenes Church**.

Greet the sun from the tower of **Dzērbenes Castle** or, together with a guide, get to know the ghost stories of the castle. The bravest can test their skills in the castle's basement escape game.

LANDSCAPES OF CĒSIS SURROUNDINGS



Length: **16 km, circular**

Difficulty level: **moderate**

Starting point: **Cēsis New Castle**

Embark on an exciting 16 km walk through the surroundings of **Cēsis**, where nature awaits with breathtaking views and rich history. Start your journey at the impressive **Cēsis New Castle**. The path then leads along Lenču Street past Meža Cemetery, where you can see the **Mother Earth sculpture** created by Jansons. Next, enjoy a walk through the forest trail to **Ērgļi Cliffs**, which rise 20 meters above the **Gauja River**. There you can catch your breath and admire the stunning view of the river valley, which is included in the **UNESCO World Heritage List**. Further along the forest road, head to the talented Janson family's art creation place "**Silķes**", where sculptures that can be seen daily in the old town of Cēsis have been created. In the final stretch, you can explore the ancient wooden villas, and at the end, treat yourself to something delicious at one of the cafes in the **old town of Cēsis**.

WHAT TO EXPERIENCE AROUND?

Visit the **Cēsis Castle** complex with its majestic medieval fortress, museum exhibitions, and themed events.

Explore the artistic creations of sculptor Kārlis Jansons at his family home "**Silķes**".

Enjoy picturesque landscapes and take a walk along the trails of **Gauja National Park** to **Ērgļi Cliffs**. Relax with SPA procedures offered by "**Villa Santa**".

JAUNPIEBALGA - VIŅĶU HILL

Length: **17 km, circular** (bike route Nr. 161)

Difficulty level: **moderate**

Starting point: **Gaujas street 21, Jaunpiebalga**

The 17 km long route will take you through the enchanting landscape of **Piebalga**, allowing you to explore not only the scenic beauty but also the cultural and historical values of **Jaunpiebalga** center: the **Jaunpiebalga Lutheran church**, where you can see the monument created by K. Zāle in memory of those who fell in the fight for freedom, as well as a State cultural monument - the tavern building, which was built in 1800 and is the largest building of this type in Latvia. Climbing the observation tower on **Viņķu Hill**, built in 2019, offers a breathtaking view of the vast fields of Piebalga. It almost begs for a canvas and a palette of colors to paint this landscape. Looking at the 17.8 m high observation tower, you can try to guess what message artist Sandra Strēle has hidden in Latvian runes. Along the route, you can also visit **PuuceStudio** ceramics workshop, where pottery is imbued with the colors of Piebalga



WHAT TO EXPERIENCE AROUND?

Where better to learn about the history of Jaunpiebalga than at the **Jaunpiebalga Local History Museum** with an experienced guide. Explore and purchase linen costumes and textiles at the **“Baltie darbi”** workshop. Jaunpiebalga is special with its dome **“Pūces”**, where for several years the ceramics workshop **“puuceStudio”** has been operating, creating unique ceramic products.

KĀRĻA SCENIC LOOP



Length: **21 km, circular**

Difficulty level: **moderate**

Starting point: **The Āraiši Lake Castle
Archaeological Park**

This circular route will delight both experienced hiking enthusiasts and cyclists, offering the opportunity to explore various natural features and understand the local environment and history. Starting your journey in **Āraiši**, head along the old **Āža tavern** towards the highway. On both sides of the road, you can observe quarrying activities. Further along, the route leads along a gravel road, crossing the **Rakšupe River** several times. Turning off at the “Saulītes” house, a forest path will take you to the **“Rakši” camel park**, where you can feed various exotic animals by hand. Nearby in the forest, you’ll find the colorful **Rakstu cliffs**. Continue along the **Mežtaka** section to **Kārļi**, where the road leads through an impressive alley of oak trees. Stop at **Kārļamuiža Hotel** to visit the pomological garden and landscape park. The final stretch of the route leads back to the starting point, passing by the beautiful **Āraiši Windmills** and **Drabeši Manor**, where there is still an active cultural life. If you still have energy, play the **“Āraiši Legends”** game, which tells the legends of the surrounding area.

WHAT TO EXPERIENCE AROUND?

Enjoy relaxation and adventure in **Drabeši** parish! Visit the leisure complex and **Zoo “Rakši”**, where you can see various exotic animals and enjoy various activities. Explore the historic **Āraiši Windmills** and learn about their operation. Get to know Latvia’s ancient history at the **Āraiši Lake Castle Archaeological Park**, where you can see the reconstructed lake castle, learn about life on **Meita Island**, and explore the ruins of **Āraiši Castle**. Play the game **“Āraiši Legends”**. Test your skills and participate in various outdoor activities with huskies at **“Dodkepu.lv”**.

LIEPA, LĪČU – LAŅĢU CLIFFS

Length: **9 km, circular**

Difficulty level: **easy/moderate**

Starting point: **parking lot**

Note! During leafless periods, the rock formations are more visible! Not suitable for stroller walks.

Līču-Laņģu trail offers an exciting walk through picturesque landscapes, revealing the wonders of nature. The trail begins at **Lielā Ellīte** - an impressive cave that is 12 meters deep and 18 meters wide. Next, the trail leads through **Liepa** to the **Lodes clay quarry**. This quarry still produces clay for brick production. The characteristic features of the quarry are steep sandstone walls and colorful layers of clay. Further on, the trail winds through the forest, offering views of the ancient **Gauja valley** and the Līču-Laņģu cliffs - a kilometer-long sandstone outcrop with a maximum height of 30 meters. It is one of the largest sandstone outcrop complexes in Latvia. Over time, the springs flowing from the cliffs have formed many caves, niches, and grottos, which continue to change.

WHAT TO EXPERIENCE AROUND?

Visit the **Veidenbaums Memorial Museum “Kalāči”**, where you will learn about the work of the poet **Eduards Veidenbaums**. Try your hand at baking rye bread or pies at the **“Krūmiņi”** bakery. Enjoy the historical atmosphere and thematic events at **Skangaļi Manor**. Relax at the **“Sillakas”** fish farm, where you can both catch fish and stay overnight.

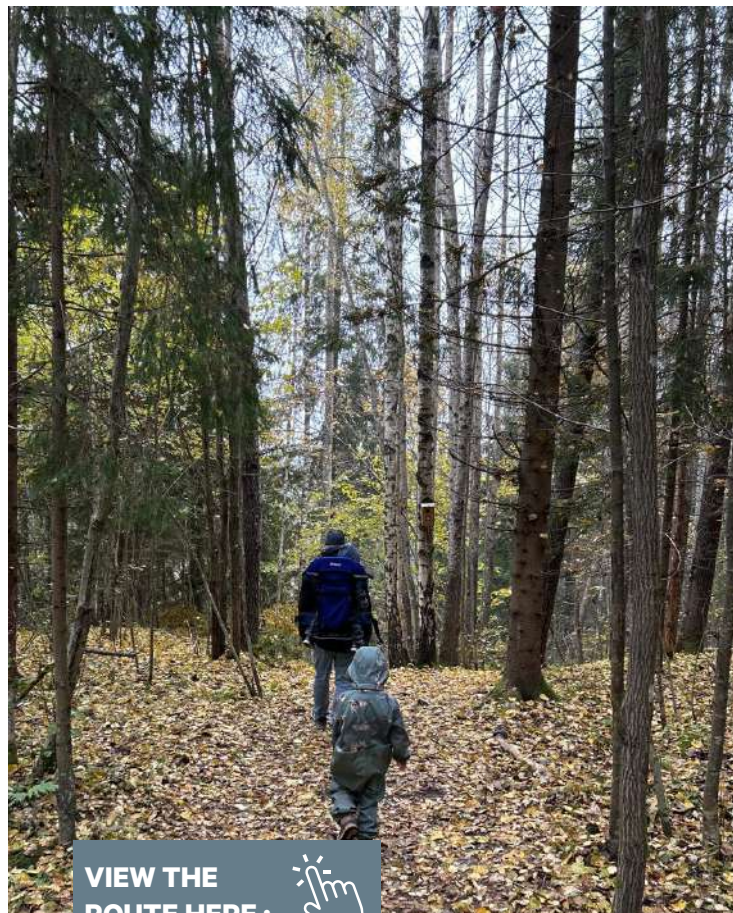

THE SOUND OF SPRING

THE MOST PICTURESQUE HERALDS OF SPRING ARE THE MIGRATORY BIRDS, DELIGHTING WITH THEIR SONGS AND DANCES. **ĒRIKS DREIBANTS** RECOMMENDS TAKING BINOCULARS, HEADING INTO NATURE, AND OBSERVING THESE COLORFUL SINGERS!

How and why to go birdwatching?

To go birdwatching, you first need an interest. Secondly, it's good if you can start by going with someone knowledgeable who can show you where to hear and see things. Since we Latvians love being in nature, birdwatching is an added value. Birdwatching is very harmonious and calming because when you're searching for a bird species, you can forget yourself for hours. While birdwatching, you set yourself up to be quieter. Go, for example, to the **Daibe Bird Tower**, take a thermos, sandwiches, and understand that now you'll enjoy three hours of birdwatching without rush. Maybe five or six. And in the end, you'll return home relaxed and serene.

Why is spring a great time for birdwatching?

In early spring, when migratory birds haven't returned yet, I enjoy listening to the song of the blackbird in the dark forest. It sounds so beautiful! It reminds you that spring is just around the corner. This is a great time for birdwatching, especially for beginners who recognize birds by appearance but not by sound, as the leaves have not yet unfolded, and they can be seen well in the tree branches.

Where to go to listen to bird songs?

Birds can be observed everywhere, even in cities where many think there are no birds. In fact, there are various species even in cities. Just stop and observe! Starting from March evenings, go to listen to the owl calls, for example, in the **Ciruliši nature trails** or **Kvēpenes trails**. To hear birds, you can use owl call recordings available on the website www.putni.lv. Download the most popular owl call in Latvia and play it in the forest. If there's a male nearby, he'll respond, saying, "Hey, this territory is already taken!" Ornithologists call this provocation. On the other hand, in early spring, when the fields are flooded with water and the time of geese migration begins, go to watch the geese on **Raiskums**, where the meadows are flooded. There you can observe them in flocks. Later in spring, when the ground has already dried, go birdwatching along the trail that connects **Līgatne** with **Cēsis**.

What to prepare when going birdwatching:

- Weather-appropriate clothing;
- Binoculars;
- Bird guidebook;
- Lunch and water.

What greenery to look for in nature in spring?

From March until the budding of leaves, you can gather buds from trees and shrubs that you recognize. You can collect apple tree buds, as well as currant bush buds. Gather soft, semi-blossomed lime tree buds, where the leaves are already emerging, as well as the young shoots of fir trees from the ends of branches, while they are about an inch long. Along the forest edge, look for sorrel and cowslip (leaves and flowers), while in the garden, go for “weeds”: nettles, ground elder, dandelions, hedgemustards, and shepherd’s purse leaves.

Seasonal eating! Blend a few buds (no more than 5-10) together with some greens in a smoothie. Add semi-blossomed tilia tree buds to salads, but eat fir tree shoots as they are, while walking in the forest! They are pleasantly tangy in taste and refreshingly quenching. Garden and forest herbs and weeds can be added to any salad. Quickly blanch dandelion leaves in hot water before using to remove bitterness.

How to best absorb the power of plants within oneself? That varies for everyone, but the main thing is to do everything with joy! If you don’t enjoy it and aren’t in the mood, it’s better not to start. If you add your joy to every dish you cook, it will be good! The most important thing is to say THANK YOU to nature.

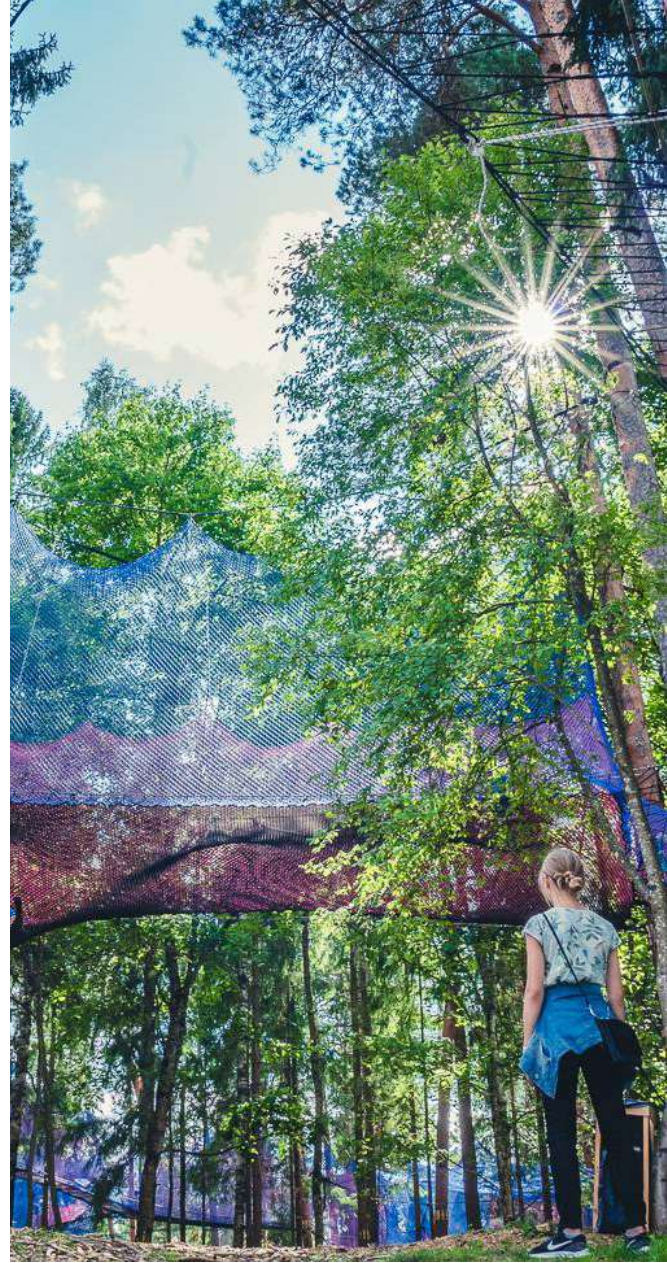

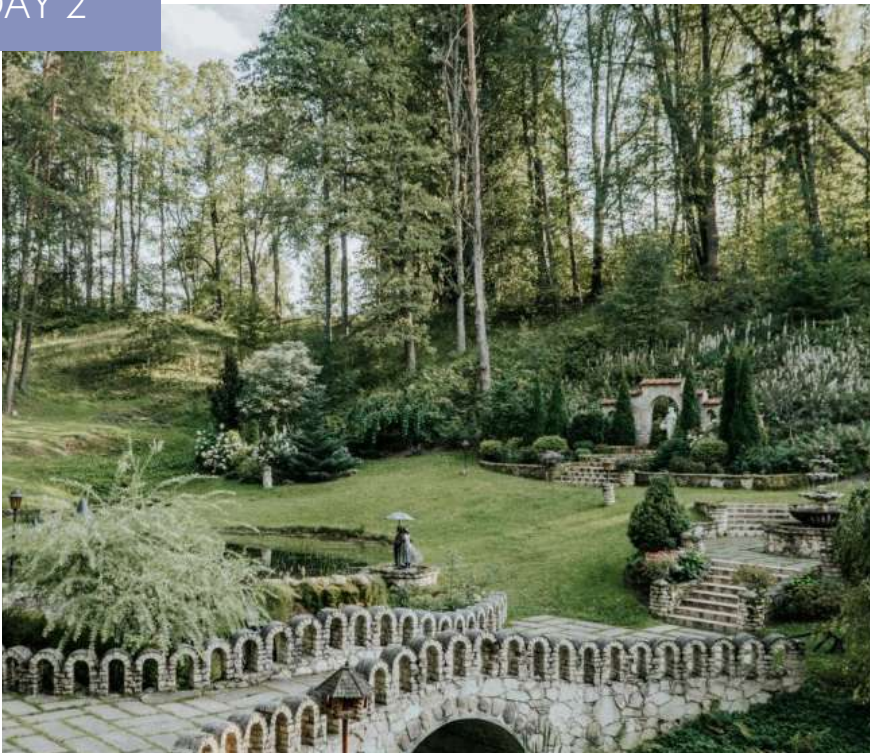

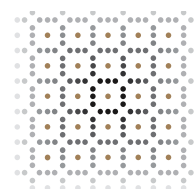
PIEBALGA: A VALUE OF LATVIA'S INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE

SINCE 2023, **PIEBALGA'S CULTURAL SPACE** HAS BEEN A VALUE OF LATVIA'S INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE. AND IT'S NOT WITHOUT REASON. **PIEBALGA** BOASTS GLITTERING LAKES, WINDING ROADS, AND LEGENDS IN ITS HILLS AND VALLEYS. THE GREAT PLAIN WHERE THE GAUJA BEGINS ITS COURSE, **THE SEVEN-ISLAND LAKE INESIS**, AND THE **SINGING WATER LILIES**. IT'S THE HOMELAND OF CULTURE, ART, AND LITERATURE, **THE CRADLE OF LATVIAN CULTURE**. VISITING PIEBALGA IS ALWAYS LIKE A SMALL JOURNEY IN TIME, BECAUSE THE SPIRIT OF THE PAST COEXISTS HERE WITH THE ACTIVE PRESENT. THE ROADS OF PIEBALGA ARE AN ADVENTURE. One of these roads leads from **Vecpiebalga** to the native **"Jāņaskola"** of the notable Latvian composer **Emīls Dārziņš** in **Jaunpiebalga**. The place where the author of the "Melancholic Waltz" spent his childhood, music is still playing today. **The Emīls Dārziņš and Jānis Sudrabkalns Memorial Museum "Jāņaskola"** is a cultural site where you can learn about the life story of the outstanding Latvian composer and get closer to the secrets of his genius work. The forget-me-not meadows, the spring hustle and bustle of storks in the "Jāņaskola" nest, the silence and the sun's play in the **Piebalga hills** invite you to indulge in the enchantment of nature.

Continuing the journey along the white roads of **Piebalga**, we invite you to visit the rural exhibition **"Vēveri"**. In the characteristic rural setting of **Old Piebalga**, it's a place for walks and an opportunity to try out your skills in weaving, churning butter, or baking bread. **"Vēveri"** welcomes you with at least 400 years of ancient history, restored Piebalga farmhouses, and craftsmen's tools from looms to spinning wheels, from carts to cradles. At the highest point of **Vēveri Hill**, 226 m above sea level, rise the Vēveri windmills, which mark an accent in the landscape nowadays rarely seen.

In the weaving workshop **"Vēverišas"** skilled weavers' hands cultivate the beauty of this land into shawls, scarves, and tablecloths. Textile artist Dagnija Kupče works there. Together with other masters in **Vecpiebalga** and **Cēsis**, she takes care of preserving intangible cultural heritage – Latvian authentic folk costumes.
